

## उत्तर पूर्वी क्षेत्रीय भार परेशान केंद्र /North Eastern Regional Load Despatch Centre Precautionary Measures Undertaken for Battling COVID-19 Pandemic

- Essential dry food items such as rice, dal, pulses, salt etc. items were distributed among needy communities by NERLDC in Guwahati and Shillong on 1<sup>st</sup> May, 7<sup>th</sup> May and 11<sup>th</sup> May 2020 in different localities with the coordination of local authorities.
- 2. All departments fully sanitised and entry restricted with effect from 15th April, 2020 up to 7<sup>th</sup> June 2020.
- 3. Office Catering and dining facilities are restricted only for staff on duty and exigencies.
- 4. All persons entering office premises are being screened before entry by using non-contact forehead thermometer.
- 5. Use of face masks have been made mandatory.
- 6. Hand sanitisers are placed in all departments whereas the office building and furniture is sanitised twice daily with Sodium Chloride disinfectant.
- 7. Meetings and trainings/seminars are carried out in NERLDC via WEBEX and Microsoft Teams.
- 8. NERLDC Main Control Room is being sanitised three times a day. Real time security desk is shifted to 1<sup>st</sup> floor and contingency control room is set up in township B-Type quarters for emergency operations.
- 9. Fresh face masks are being distributed among employees and contractual workers from time- to- time.
- 10. Home quarantine facility for the newly joined ETs have been arranged in NERLDC Transit camp with hygiene and sanitisation protocols including food delivery.
- 11.NERLDC Shillong obtained permission from Office of Superintendent of Police on 23/03/2020 for allowing POSOCO officials to come to duty. Vehicle passes, permission letters were issued to employees and outsourced staff for movement from home to office.

- 12. Similary, NERLDC Guwahati obtained permission from Office of Deputy Commissioner on 25th March 2020 for allowing POSOCO officials to attend office.
- 13. All sanitary items like hand washes, soaps, sanitizers, tissue papers, gloves, masks etc are stocked in HR for a period of at least 3 months.
- 14. In both Shillong and Guwahati offices, during pan India lockdown, HODs were attending duty regularly with one-third of their staff present. The remaining two- thirds were advised "Work from Home" on rotation basis as per CC guidelines w.e.f 23/03/2020 to 7/06/2020. Considering second lockdown in Guwahati w.e.f 29/06/2020, NERLDC Guwahati has reimplemented Work from Home with only 1/3rd of staff being physically present.
